Article Submission Guidelines

Following are guidelines for submitting an article to New Accountant magazine:

- We only publish articles written by college/university professors. As such, the acceptance rate is typically very high as long as the topic is relevant to students.
- Topic must be a subject of interest for college students majoring in Accounting and written so that it is understood by students.
- Word count can be between 800 – 1,750. Anything over that will have to be preapproved, depending on topic and overall length, and possibly published in two parts, in two separate issues.
- Should be submitted in word document format, double-spaced and should include an intro or abstract page with a brief description of the article, and should include all authors and their respective accreditation, contact information and school/employer information.
- References may be included at the end, however may not be published due to space constraints.
- Articles in New Accountant are not peer reviewed, however, we will peer review your manuscript if you notify us in writing you wish have this go through New Accountant's peer review process.
- When the article passes the peer review process and published, the editor will label the article, in the magazine, as peer reviewed.
- Please include jpg headshots of all authors with your article.

Once received, you will get an email notification of receipt and your article will be reviewed and slated for publication in an upcoming issue, unless you hear otherwise from our staff.
